### ~Sunday School Scoop

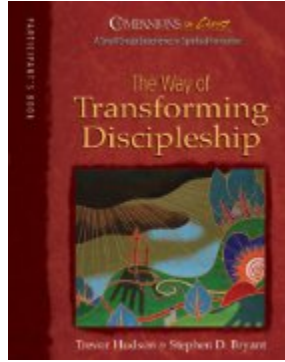
